Background.

This is an implementing phase as a follow up of the formulation of the TCP/UGA/8821 which provided funds for:

- Identification of programme sites.
- Soil survey and analysis of soil samples.
- Purchase of office equipment and a programme vehicle.

Phase II of the programme will be incorporated into the planned investments for the Plan for Modernisation of Agriculture (PMA).

Objectives.

- (i) Improve food security through demonstrating economically sustainable methodologies for increasing agricultural productivity and overall production.
- (ii) Operationalisation of the 100 irrigation pumps donated to Uganda by the Government of India.
- (iii) Outputs and performance indicators missing

Technical Description.

The programme has the following components:

- Water harvesting and control.
- Low to medium cost irrigation technology demonstration.
- Crop/animal intensification and diversification.
- Constraint analysis.
- Extension staff and farmer training.
- Formulation of a National Steering Committee to oversee the activities of the programme.

Financing.

The programme is funded by the GoU and US \$ 0.052 million was provided for in the estimates for the FY 2000/01.
